"Framework Development of Public
Works Procurement System in Indonesia"**

Background

One of the efforts that are considered to improve the public welfare in Indonesia is provision of good infrastructure that accelerates country development. Although the investment of construction works in Indonesia is increasing year by year, the growth of investment is not fully supported by performance improvement of construction project. The modest project performance leads to low value for money of investment. Performance improvement of each infrastructure project by an even few percentage would save billion dollars of value for money. The achievement of high performance of construction projects is very significant for supporting socio economic development of the country.

In order to do so, the Indonesian construction industry needs to develop implementation processes of infrastructure projects in a comprehensive manner. Ideal goal of this change is to share the optimum benefits among stakeholders involved in construction works. In order to find the direction and process of the change, careful studies and intensive discussions are indispensable. Thus, supports from academic societies are very important.

One of the crucial issues in the provision of good infrastructure is the public works procurement process, which should be implemented in an effective, efficient, timely and accountable manner, to obtain best value for money in infrastructure investment. Despite the effort for procurement reform which has been commenced in Indonesia, through the establishment of an Institute for Policy on Public Procurement (LKPP) and the enacting of new governmental regulation (Perpres 54/2010) on public procurement, it is felt that there are still many obstacles hampering the progress in improving the public infrastructure projects' performance.

Cooperation between the Japan Society of Civil Engineers (JSCE), the Institution of Engineers Indonesia (PII), Construction Development Agency (BP Konstruksi), Institut Teknologi Bandung (ITB) would be timely and useful. Both countries are challenged to solve a common problem: how to best reform public procurement, in order to have better public

infrastructure performance and best value for money invested. Research conducted by the JSCE focusing on improvement and maintenance of performance of the construction industry would be useful to the Indonesian academic society and construction industry. Indonesian researches aiming at overcoming shortage of professional human resources should also be valuable to Japan. Building network to share knowledge and experience is desirable for both countries.

Seminar Objectives

Since this seminar is held in Jakarta, Indonesia, it is mainly focused on public works procurement reform in Indonesia. The objectives of this seminar are to:

1. exchange research outputs, ideas, and experiences on reform of public works procurement systems between the two societies,
2. encourage Indonesian construction service communities to express and share opinions, ideas, and proposals on public procurement reform in Indonesia,
3. promote Japanese construction service communities to share value and confidence of the reform process and support Indonesian communities, and
4. build mutual trust between the two societies.
