







COVID-19 in Taiwan – Level 3 Alert

COVID-19 Level 3 Alert in Effect Around Taiwan Through May 28

(May 2021 to Feb., 2022)



- For all schools, teaching should be conducted online instead. Tutoring centers, kindergartens and day-care services are closed. Employers should allow paid or non-paid leave for workers who need to look after their underage children.
- For businesses and offices that remain open, compliance with COVID-19-related preventive measures are required.
- All members of the public are required to wear a mask at all times except at home.
- Cinemas, sports centers, libraries, exhibitions, bars, and adult entertainment venues are closed.
- Gatherings of 5+ people indoors or 10+ outdoors are prohibited.
- Restaurants are required to use ID-based registration, socially-distant seating and/or partitions or provide take-out/delivery service only.
- Members of the public are advised to avoid unnecessary travels.









SHELTER PLANNING UNDER THE PANDEMIC

According to “the Guideline of Refugee Shelters under COVID-19” (Issued in Apr., 2020)

Home quarantine —→

Go to Shelters

Regular evacuees —→

Collective quarantine facility or hotels

Priority to Hotels, Hostels

For each evacuation shelter

In door <100 persons

Facilities with greater capacity

Special evaluation

Secure proper distance

General: **1.5m** in door, **1m** out door

Dining: **1.5m** + plastic shields





High Speed Rail

QR-Code Contact Based Registration System

- ✓ **0.62 billion** (620,000,000) **SMS** in the first 40 days (2021/05-2021/06)
- ✓ **47.9 billion** (4,790,000,000) **SMS** in 340 days (2021/05-2022/04)
- ✓ **43 million** (43,000,000) **inquiries** in total (2021/05-2022/04)
- ✓ **A large-size department store would have 70,000 SMS per day.**

Taiwan Social Distance APP

- ✓ Detects nearby users via **Bluetooth** signals (**<2m & >2min**)
- ✓ Records the **duration** of distance from each contact
- ✓ Alerts users to any contact with COVID-positive users in the **past 14 days**
- ✓ **Decentralized** and requires no registration or information to be uploaded

CONCLUSIONS

- ▶ Covid-19 has affected Taiwan dearly **since May, 2021.**
- ▶ New normal includes regulation and instructions were applied in **daily life** and also in **disaster management.**
- ▶ **More** pre-planning and management **efforts** considering COVID-19 for evacuation and shelters were required.
- ▶ New IT tech (**QR-Code scan, APP social distance**) were introduced to monitor the flow of the crowds.
