



Announcement for our new official name: HANOI UNIVERSITY OF CIVIL ENGINEERING

Dear Valued Partners,

The Rector Board of National University of Civil Engineering is proud to announce that on August 13, 2021, Deputy Prime Minister Vu Duc Dam signed the decision on changing our official name into HANOI UNIVERSITY OF CIVIL ENGINEERING, with our main campus situated in Hanoi.

The University of Civil Engineering was established under Decision No. 144/CP dated August 8, 1966 by the Government, formerly the Faculty of Civil Engineering of Hanoi University of Science and Technology. During wartime, the university had to evacuate to many locations such as Ha Bac or Vinh Phu Provinces. At the end of 1983, we moved back to Hanoi and in 1991, the whole university finally consolidated at the address of 55 Giai Phong Road, Dong Tam Ward, Hai Ba Trung District, Hanoi. Along with these events, our name was altered several times due to the need of realistic situations. In this year of 2021, the university proudly adopted the official name of Hanoi University of Civil Engineering (abbreviated as HUCE), affirming the bond with our root city – Hanoi Capital.

The year 2021 also marks our celebration of 55 years of establishment and development, and 65 years of training experience. Throughout this time, Hanoi - National University of Civil Engineering has become a leading center for training, scientific research, technology transfer and supply high-quality human resources for the country in the field of engineering.

With this change, we unify and synchronize our brand identity with local and international partners, and will strive forward to our recognition in the world rankings. Hanoi University of Civil Engineering aims to become one of the leading universities in engineering and technology by 2030, reaching regional and international levels.

HANOI UNIVERSITY OF CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSULTANCY CO., LTD (CCU) JOINS THE URGENT CONSTRUCTION OF A FIELD HOSPITAL IN HANOI

Approved by the Government, the Hanoi People's Committee assigned the Medical University Hospital to build a field hospital to resuscitate severe and critical Covid-19 patients with a scale of more than 500-700 beds.

LAUNCHING PROJECT 89: ON IMPROVING THE CAPACITY OF LECTURERS AND MANAGERIAL OFFICERS AT HIGHER EDUCATION FACILITIES TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF FUNDAMENTAL AND COMPREHENSIVE RENOVATION OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN THE 2019-2030 PERIOD

On January 18, 2019, the Prime Minister released Decision 89/QD-TTg 2019 approving the plan on improving the capacity of lecturers and managerial officers at higher education facilities to meet the requirements of fundamental and comprehensive renovation of education and training in the 2019-2030 period. In the next 10 years, Vietnam's tertiary education needs to have an additional 7,300 university lecturers with a doctoral degree and 300 lecturers at culture, arts and sports schools with a master's degree.

University lecturers would be sent to training courses for doctoral degree under three ways: full-time training in Vietnam, full-time training overseas, or training both in Vietnam and overseas. Schools are responsible for managing and distributing scholarships under Project 89 to the lecturers sent to training courses.

Hanoi University of Civil Engineering is one of the universities in the list of participating in the Project. The university has called and received a lot of interest and registration from the lecturers for the first call for 2021 - 2022.



On July 9, 2021, Hanoi University of Civil Engineering issued a Decision on Regulations on organization and operation of research groups and strong research groups.

The aim is to build a specialized and interdisciplinary research environment with long-term, continuous and succession strategies to promote scientific research and technology transfer activities of HUCE; developing a team of prestigious scientific experts, contributing to solving scientific-practical problems, contributing to the development of the country and improving the quality of status of HUCE; promoting international cooperation with domestic and international partners. Strong research groups/research groups must assure the requirements for clear development orientation in terms of goals, content and products, associated with training activities and continuous operation plan, and meet human resource standards requirements.

TEMASEK FOUNDATION SPECIALISTS' COMMUNITY ACTION AND LEADERSHIP EXCHANGE - TF SCALE 2021

TF SCALE programme will be organized by Singapore Polytechnic (SP), funded by Temasek Foundation in from 6 September 2021 to 11 March 2022.

TF SCALE is a 3-part programme and will be held virtually. It aims to provide 120 student-leaders from 4 university included HUCE with a unique opportunity to:

- foster a deeper understanding and appreciation of the issues and challenges facing Asia, with a focus on leadership, technology and enterprise;
- inspire student-leaders to take definitive actions and contribute to their future; and
- build leadership capabilities and develop friendship among youth leaders.
